Providers with 0 to 2 residents conduct a drill at least every 3 months. Providers with 3 or 4 residents conduct a drill each month. For all drills conducted during a certification year, at least half must be fire drills. Fire drills must show that all who participated reached a point of safety outside the home in under 3 minutes.
